1. Introductions: None.

2. Approval of August 26, 2015 Minutes: Postponed until next meeting.

3. Announcements:

- October 28th Rock River Recovery Forum for TMDL implementation with agricultural theme, and possible Monitoring Committee Meeting

4. Treasurer's Report:

6. Stream Monitoring Report:

 - 2016 will be a "gap year" for Yahara with continued citizen monitoring, working under the expired Memorandum of Understanding. In 2017 the new intergovernmental agreement for a full-scale adaptive management program should be in place.
- Class at Whitewater is doing EVAAL modeling for Sugar River Watershed

12. Testing the Waters a Paddle and Probe Adventure:

- Suzanne moved to write a letter suggesting the DNR uses credit on project should look to local wetland banks versus other potential uses of the funds (not sure about wording?)
 - o Joe seconded
 - o Discussion
 - Jane suggested more specific wording with a restated motion
 - We want to be sure that the wetland banks are considered for mitigationprefer wetland mitigation take place in the same subwatershed as the project
 - Eric will compose letter/Jane will send it
 - Vote passed
