Old Business

Lynne handed out Wheel Against Weeds brochure. There are also posters if anyone has a good place for them. Lynne will attend planning meeting on March 12, 8:30 am at the Koffee Kup in Stoughton; others can attend if they wish. Need to create presentation on invasive species control for event. Right now we have poster, cards, predators, spray and injection equipment, knotweed wildcards. The event is May 11 from 10-12 at the Riley Rd bridge, and lunch at Magnolia Branch Park. Sharon and Patty volunteered. Need more volunteers.

Dane County Parks/Chris James report: county can acquire land in BC watershed if opportunity arises with: willing landowner, desire on part of county, and county funds available. No other assistance unless we propose it. Caroline brought up that there used to be meetings of groups to share ideas. Could we try to have a potluck to get groups together? What can RRC do to help us?

Yahara WINS: MMSD is project sponsor. We are Interested Party. Goal is to improve Yahara Watershed water quality for less money by MMSD paying farmers to do conservation measures in areas of watershed identified as important rather than incurring a huge expenditure in water treatment which would be passed on to the customers. Leedle Mill bridge update from Jim Post emails. He found that we can't do anything about the debris in the stream. The company that designed the new bridge didn't know the debris from old bridge was there so their plan didn't include removing it. The contractor didn't know either and wasn't paid to remove, plus DNR had told them to not disturb anything. Suggest if DNR won't do anything then have to mark the hazard with buoys. Discuss at next meeting.
